
All hardware will be assessed and provided with a dollar value; all money raised will go to Marina View School

## **ROAD CROSSING & CARPARK SAFETY**

Please note some reminders below to ensure our children are safe during school drop off and pick up times.

- 1.) Please ensure you use the patrolled crossing morning and afternoon.


