COVID UPDATE

We would like to thank our community for your support during these past few weeks as we navigate through these uncertain times. We appreciate the communication between home and school regarding any Covid-19 cases, and will continue to keep you updated from our side too. This week we have had a total of 15 cases.

A reminder that last week the isolation period changed to 7 days, with the days to get tested now being day 3 and day 7, however we still encourage 10 days isolation where possible.
