COVID AND WINTER BUGS

There has been another surge in Covid cases in our community. We ask that you continue to notify the school if your child tests positive for Covid, with details of when symptoms started and the date of the positive test result, so we can continue to notify those affected. To ensure the wellbeing of all, children and staff should stay at home if they are feeling unwell (coughing, sneezing, runny nose, headache etc). Any people presenting with symptoms of sickness at school (students or staff) will be asked to return home and contact their doctor if necessary.

ATTENDANCE

We have noticed a lot of children being signed out of school before the 3pm bell. We understand of course that children have appointments, however it is really important that your child is at school the whole day. School hours: 8:50am - 3:00pm to ensure that their learning isn't impacted by being late or leaving early. 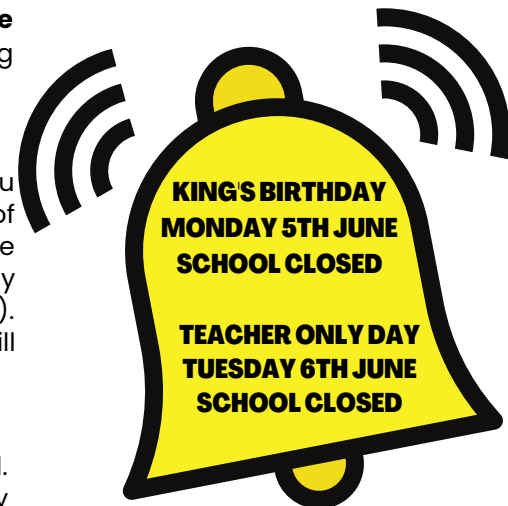

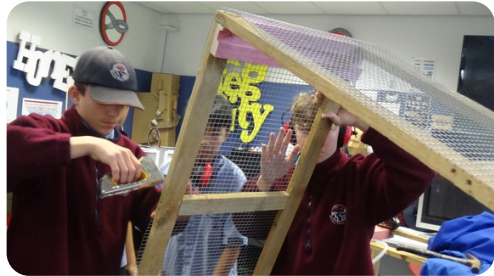


TECHNOLOGY

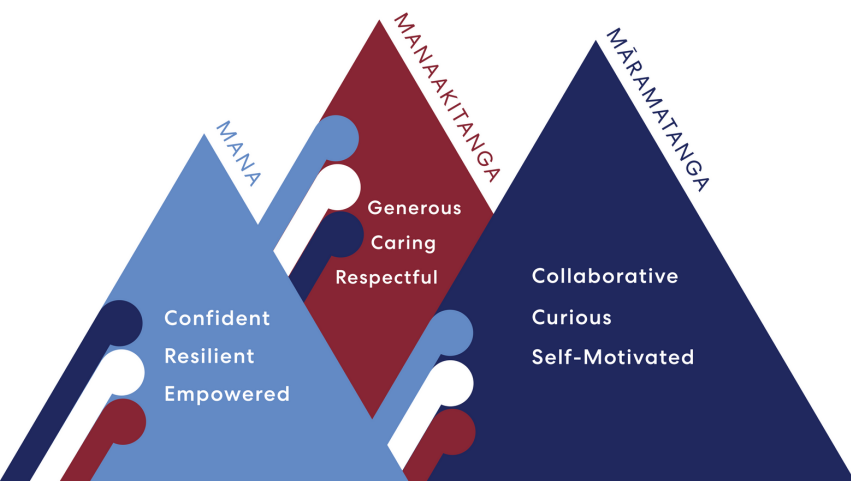

ROAD CROSSING & CARPARK SAFETY

Please note some reminders below to ensure our children are safe during school drop off and pick up times.

- 1.) Please ensure you use the patrolled crossing morning and afternoon.

- 2.) Do not drop children off in the middle of road while waiting at the crossing.

- 3.) Students should exit and enter the car from a footpath side door of a parked car.

- 4.) Parking on the yellow lines is dangerous and against the law.
