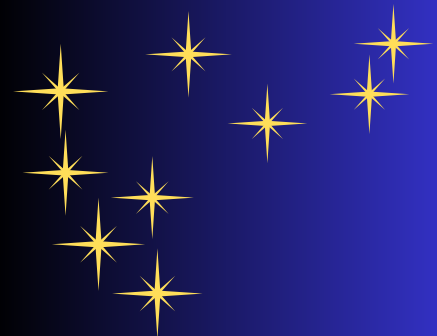

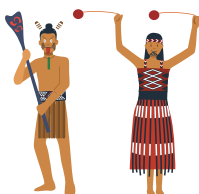

On Saturday 15th June 2024, New Zealand Modern School of Music held its Annual Competitions.

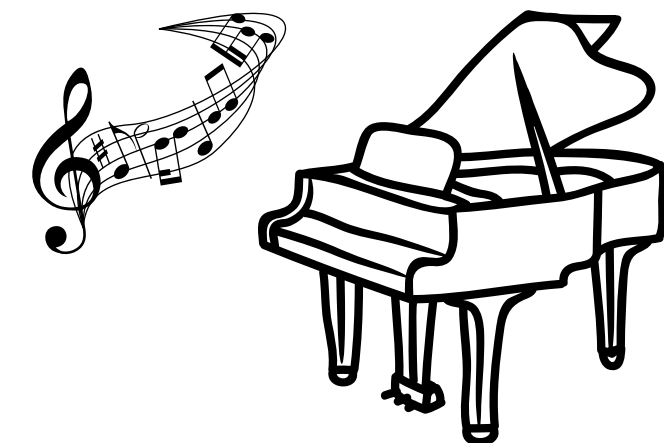
Congratulations to Evelyn Shim, Kaylee Shim, Lex Cao, Kenneth Chen and Ryan Chen for their participation.

Kenneth Chen - 1 Bronze Medal, 1 Very Highly Commended Certificate and 1 Highly Commended Certificate.





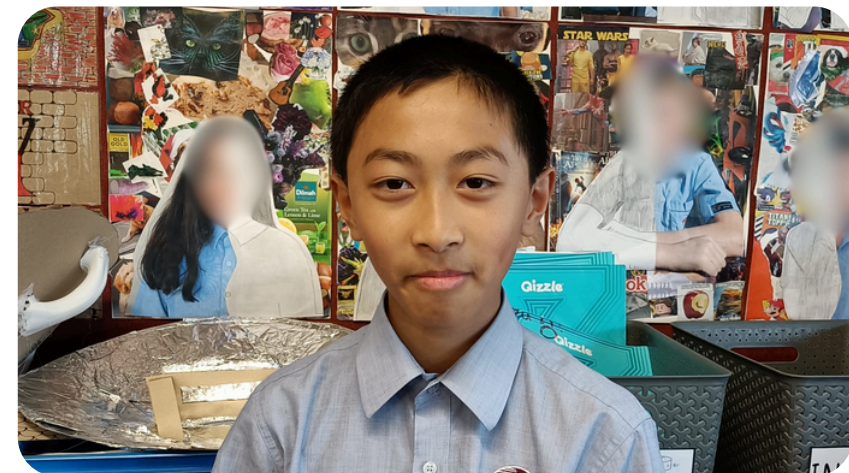
## STUDENT SUCCESS
