Congratulations to Evelyn Shim, Kaylee Shim, Lex Cao, Kenneth Chen and Ryan Chen for their participation.


Evelyn Shim received - 1 Gold Medal, 1 Silver Medals, 1 Bronze Medal and 1 Very Highly Commended certificate.


