We are planning a school disco for later in the term. More details to come closer to the time.

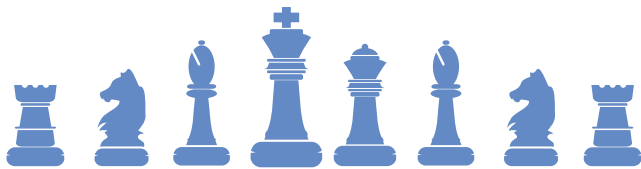


# SPORTS

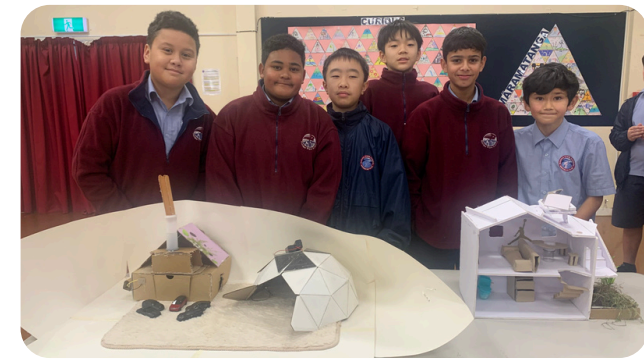
### Day & Night

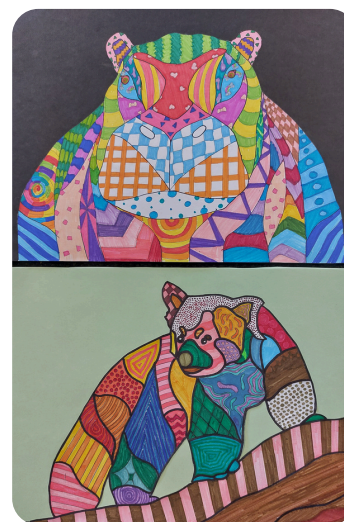
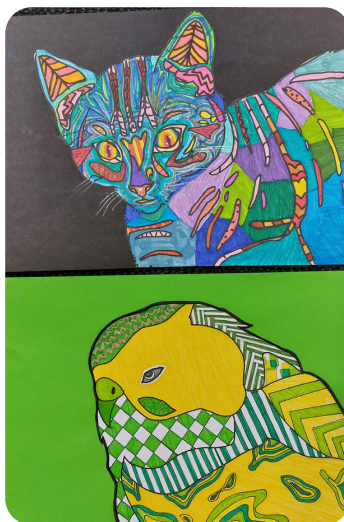


# MARINA VIEW SCHOOL MAUNGA MOMENT

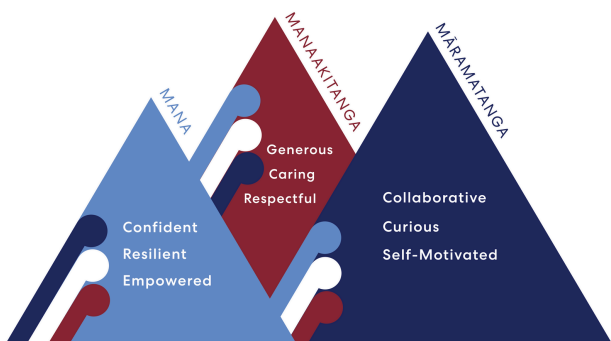
**Whaia te iti kahurangi ki te tūohu koe me he maunga teitei**

McIntosh and Fraser Dental are excited to offer two \$10,000 Orthodontic Scholarships in 2023.

Established in 2012 by Dr Alex McIntosh and Dr Milan Raniga, the scholarship was founded to help deserving students in West Auckland. Dr McIntosh and Dr Raniga saw a significant need for support and created this scholarship to give something meaningful back to the community.

Since its creation in 2012, McIntosh and Fraser Dental have transformed the smiles of 26 students by awarding \$175,000 in scholarships. This year the Orthodontic Scholarships consist of two prizes of up to \$10,000 in orthodontic treatment.

We are looking for students who have a clear need for orthodontic treatment and who excel in one of these key areas: academics, sport, the arts, cultural or community involvement. Students can be nominated by teachers, school staff, whānau and their peers.
