## YEAR 5/6 READING CHALLENGE


Last term, the year 5 and 6 tamariki took on the Annual Reading Challenge that is set by Mrs Munro, our wonderful librarian. The challenge involved reading a selection of texts and we had to either tell Mrs Munro or our year 5/6 teacher about what we had read (summarise).

This took place from our first library session of the term and ended the last week of term 2. We earned different points depending on what we read, fiction: 2 cm, non-fiction, graphic novel and Geronimo Stilton: 1 cm, picture books ½ cm. Room 15 won the challenge, reading over 650 books or 7.71 metres - enough to read from the floor to Mr Horler's height and back to the floor as well as reading Mr Young's height from the floor up and back down again. Overall, all the year 5/6 students read a grand total of 29.85 metres (or higher than a seven story building)!

The prize was a library party, and the top two readers from the other classes were also invited.













Soumya, Room 15, was the top reader in the Reading Challenge. She read 156 books during the term!
