**Thursday 13th June:** Votes are counted, and our school advised of the results.

**Friday 14th June:** New Board takes office

### ROAD CROSSING

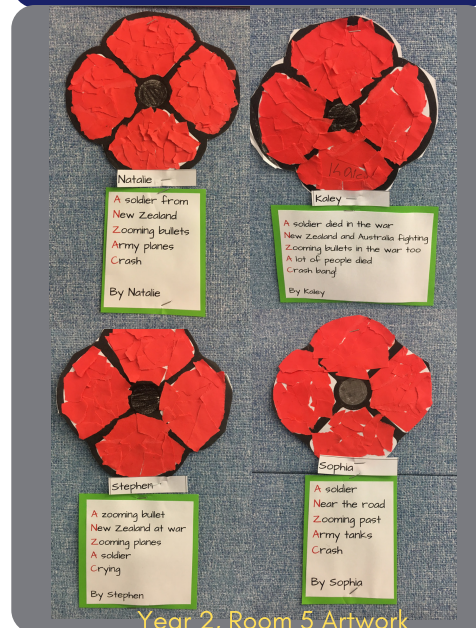

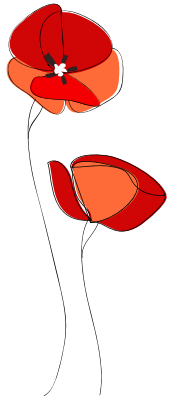


## SPORTS NEWS
