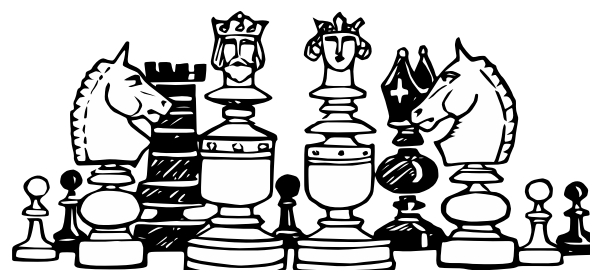


Y7/8 CHESS ZONES
