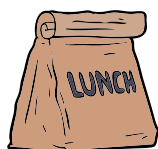

Well done to our team, great preparation for the upcoming AIMS Games in September.



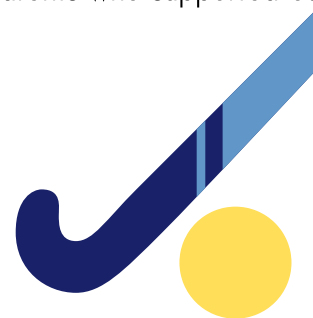
### Y5/6 & 7/8 HOCKEY ZONES

### Sama Yoga Studio

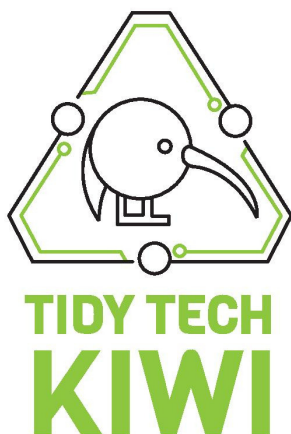
A cozy little yoga sanctuary open to everyone of all levels who seek balance (Sama) in life.

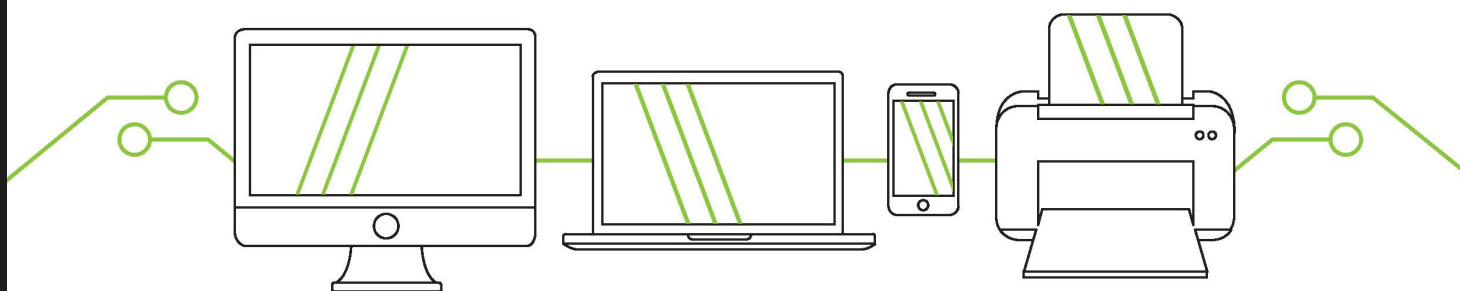
