### ROAD CROSSING SAFETY

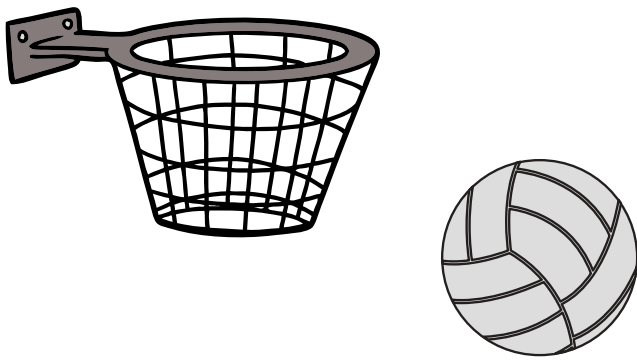




# SPORTS NEWS
