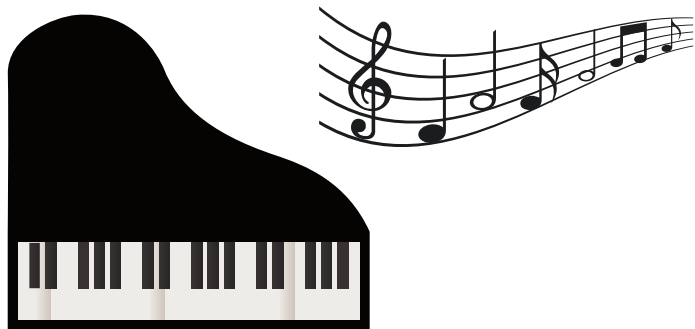
The school office and uniform shop will be open on Friday 11th October from 9am – 12:00pm. Hats can be purchased as they are requirement for Term 4.

1st Place: Ryan Long – Tamariki Kayak, Paddle & PDF

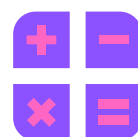
2nd Place: Tiya Kohli – HP Chromebook

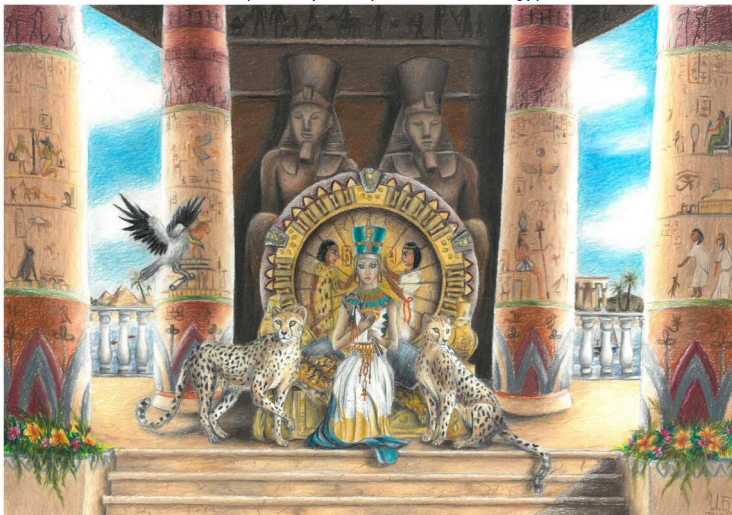


YEAR 6 CULTURAL INQUIRY

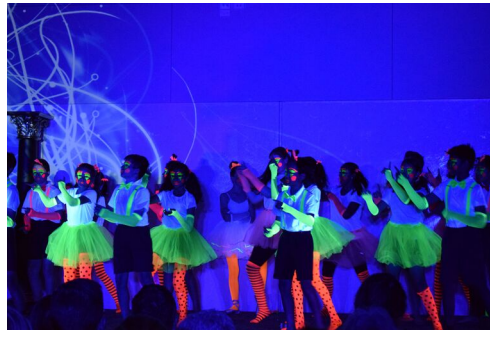

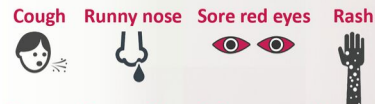
Measles in Auckland schools
