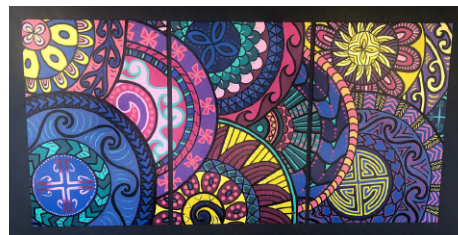

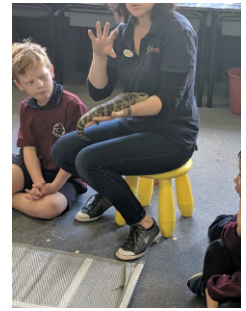
## YEAR 2 ZOOVENTURES WELLBEING EXPERIENCE
