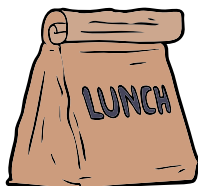
SCHOOL HATS

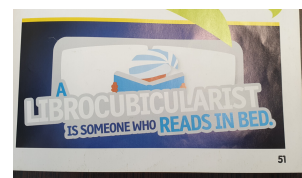

Your old, unused technology can help us fundraise!

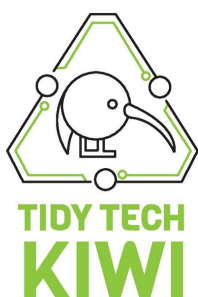
