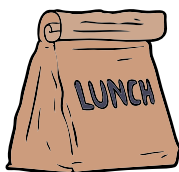

## FLASH MOB

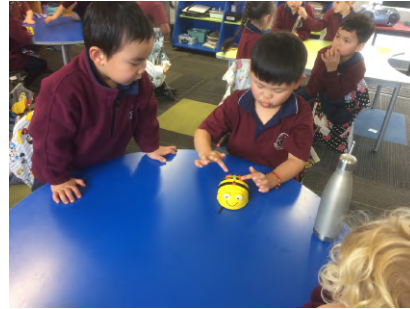
