YEAR 2 TRIP TO MUSEUM

Earlier this week the Year 2 team visited the Auckland Museum as part of their Inquiry learning into 'Enchanted Creatures'. They explored the Sea Monsters exhibition and were involved in a classroom lesson in which they got to handle fossils. They looked at fossils, skeletons, and replicas of aquatic reptiles that have been discovered in New Zealand and Australia. Some of the children's highlights included holding a fossil of a megalodon tooth, getting to design a plesiosaur, and looking in awe at the sheer scale of some of the prehistoric sea creatures.
