We encourage the children to attend the 'Meetings' so that they can take part in the discussion and talk about their learning this year.

EXCURSION PERMISSIONS

It is important to return permission/consent forms by the requested date for any trips or excursions. We are finding many students have not returned permission slips (paper or online) on time, which affects the planning that goes into these trips. Communication regarding trips is done via messages in HERO, with a link to the letter and online Google permission form. We sometimes send hard copies of permission letters home, often for sports zone days. It is vital that parents/caregivers check HERO regularly for messages and updates and complete permission forms by the requested date. If children don't return permission forms on time they will not be able to attend the trip.

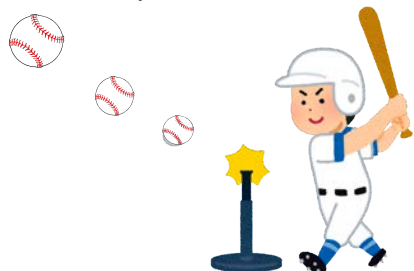


SPORTS

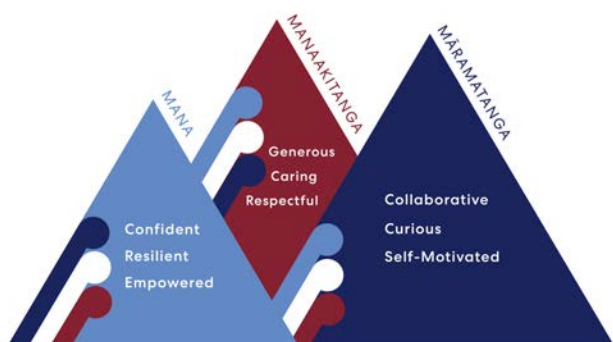


MARINA VIEW SCHOOL MAUNGA MOMENT
