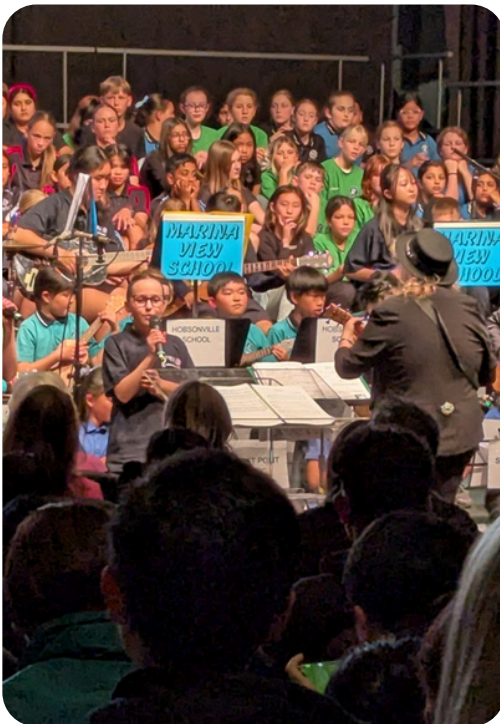


# WHIRIA TE TANGATA KĀHUI AKO MUSIC FESTIVAL

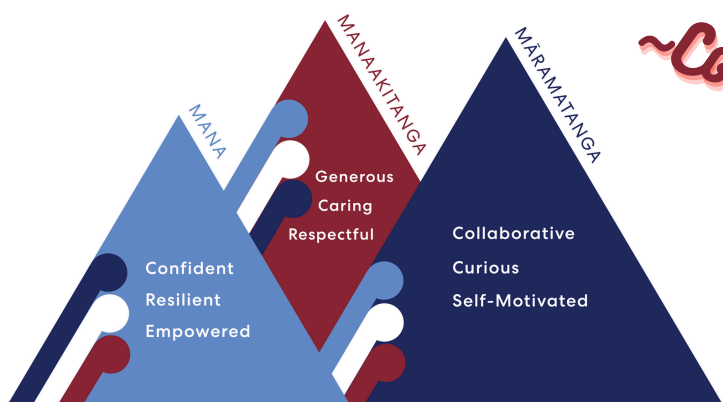

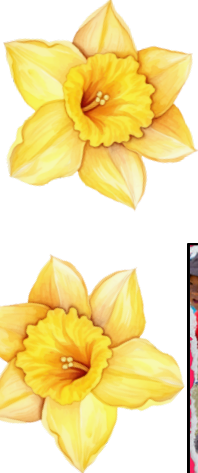
