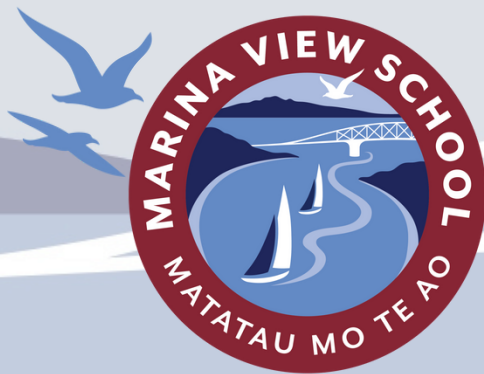

YEAR 2 TRIP TO WEST HARBOUR GARDENS

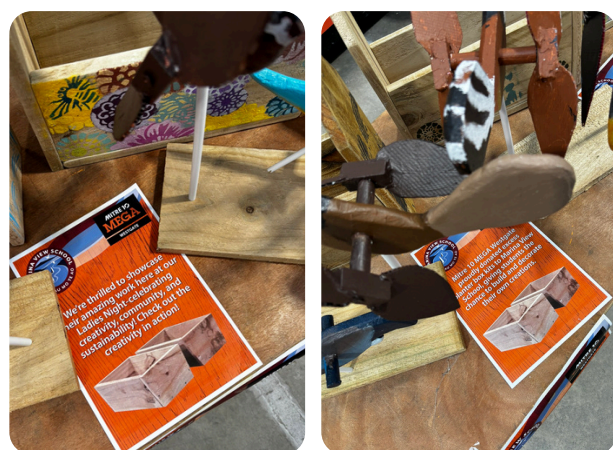

PTA FAMILY FUN NIGHT

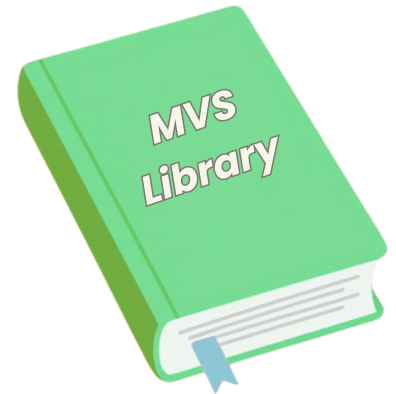

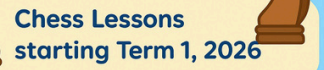
