### **PINK SHIRT MUFTI DAY**

Thank you to everyone for your support with our 'Pink Shirt Mufti Day' on Friday 15th May. It was great to see so much pink in the school to show support for standing up against bullying and spreading kindness and aroha. Our Year 7 & 8 Leaders put on a dance show and photo booth in the hall at lunchtime - there was plenty of dancing and posing for photos, and all the students loved it!

We raised \$617 for The Mental Health Foundation, which will be used to help raise awareness about bullying prevention and provide resources that promote inclusive workplaces, schools and communities.

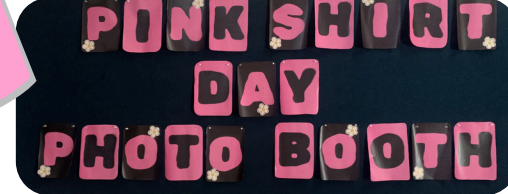
