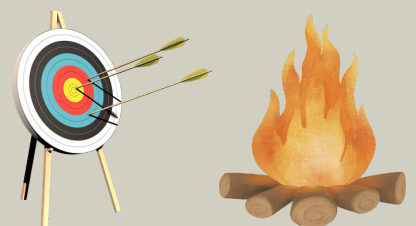

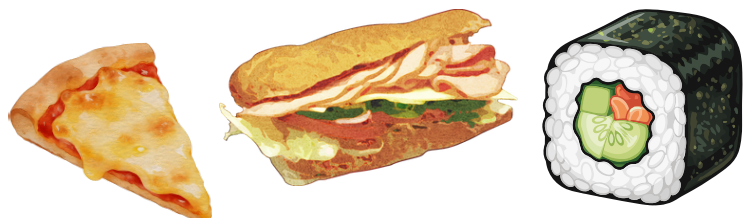
LUNCH ORDERS

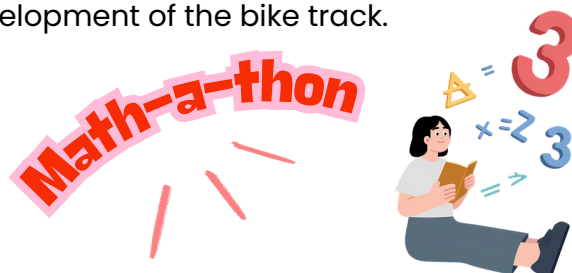

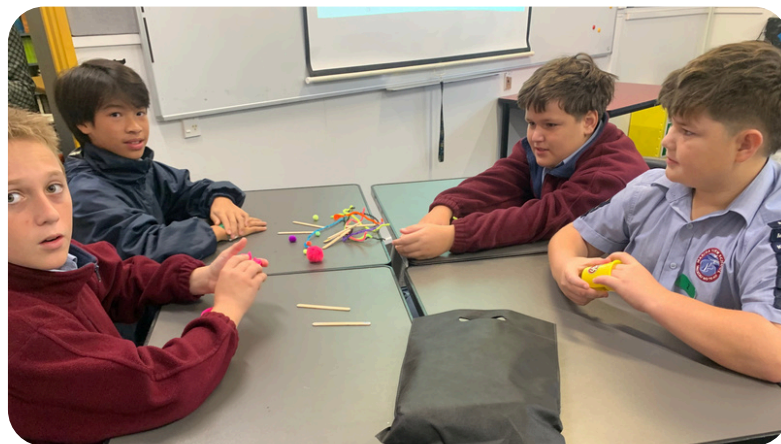

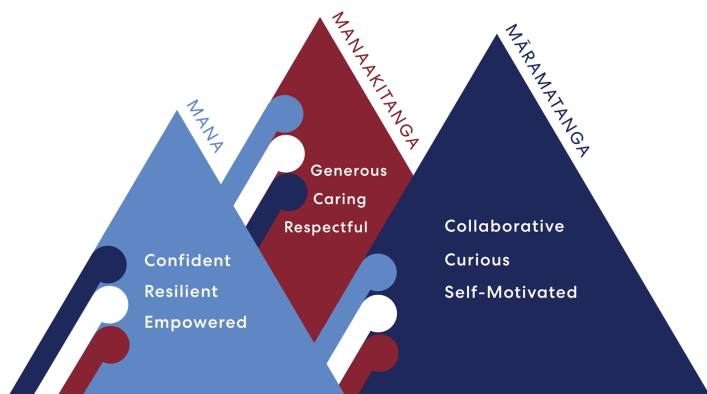
