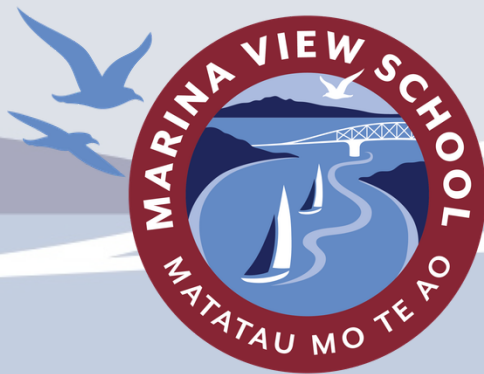

LUNCH ORDERS

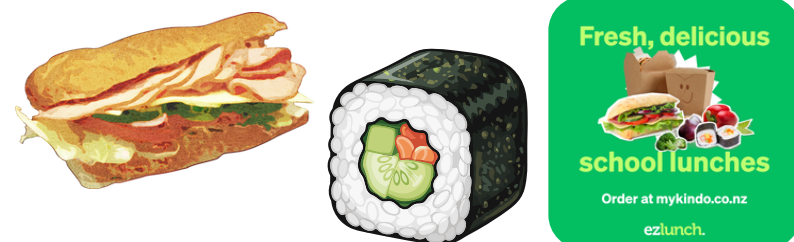
Lunch orders are available 3 days a week through Ezlunch (part of the Kindo family).

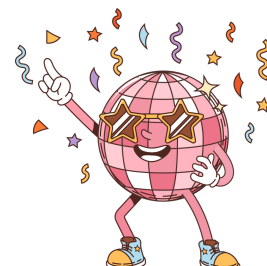
HOT DOG FUNDRAISER LUNCH

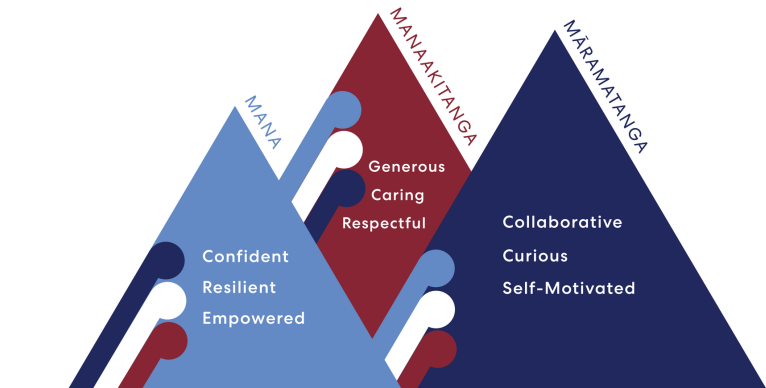
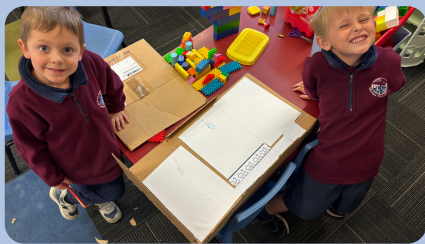
